Summer Student Fellowships offer independent research opportunities for college and university undergraduates who have completed their junior or senior years. Candidates may be studying any of the fields of science, mathematics, or engineering. This program aims to provide hands-on experience in ocean studies to a promising group of students and potential career interest in oceanography and/or marine policy.
